- Occasionally the questions in the class became too personal. This was largely due to other members of the class. The instructor perhaps should make sure the discussion stays on track.

When getting exams back, for the essay section, I would get points deducted but no comments were on the test to help me improve my writing to get a better grade and learn from it. I would say give a little more constructive feedback on exams. I think it would have really helped me to

- improve my writing. Some of the reading were really long even when split up into two parts. I would try to make those more on the weekend if possible to allow for more time to be able to read it. I found myself starting and then running out of time to read with work and other school work.
- more freedom in what we read (choices)
- If there was any discrepancy that I had with the course, it was the amount of readings per week that we were required to accomplish. Reading anything can be very taxing on a student and with so much reading it all tends to blur together.
- She always had us work in groups and I personally hate group work
