Cassini Nazir is a designer of conversations, curricula, and interfaces. He is an Assistant Professor in the College of Visual Arts and Design at the University of North Texas where he teaches classes in interaction design.

His current research explores how curiosity can be meaningfully infused into design processes. Because curiosity is linguistically rooted in the notion of care, he explores ways that designers can also extend care to those for whom they build as well as that which they choose to build.

In spring 2020, he was Designer-in-Residence for the SMU Masters in Design and Innovation (MADI) program.

Prior to joining UNT, Cassini taught at The University of Texas at Dallas for 10 years, where he directed two research labs. He was founding director of the Arts and Technology Usability Lab, which fosters collaborative research with community partners and offers experiential learning to students. He was also Director of Design for the ArtSciLab, a transdisciplinary research lab helping the arts, science, and technology communities by pursuing initiatives of societal urgency and cultural timeliness.

His academic projects include collaborations with art historians, astronauts, biochemists, brain scientists, futurists, materials scientists, new media artists, and a university press. He has worked with industry partners such as Toyota, Intuit, Sabre, DFW Airport, and projekt202.

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DESIGNING CURIOSITY · SMU / UNT

My current research focuses on ways curiosity might be infused more deeply into design processes. Curiosity is powerful but also fragile. I am developing frameworks that allow designers to deepen their curiosity and also create moments that invite curiosity into that which we choose to build. Curiosity should leave us scratching our chins, not our heads.

I was invited to give the global keynote for World Information Architecture Day in Feb 2021. My video was featured at independently organized WIAD events worldwide, premiering in 50 cities across 5 continents and translated into 8 languages.

I launched a website dedicated to curiosity to coincide with my World IA Day keynote. The site features curiosity-related resources for information architects and design professionals. Well-recognized information architects and designers have submitted original content related to curiosity such as Patricia Moore (an early founder of Universal Design), Peter Morville (a pioneer of the fields of information architect and user experience), and Norm Cox (a Xerox PARC alumnus who designed the very first computer interfaces). I continue to publish materials as well as give talks and workshops on how we can compel curiosity.

ARTSCILAB PROJECTS · UT DALLAS

ArtSciLab is a transdisciplinary research lab helping the arts, science, and technology communities by pursuing initiatives of societal urgency and cultural timeliness. The lab was founded in 2014 by Roger Malina with the opening of the Edith O'Donnell Arts and Technology building. After many successful collaborations with Roger, I took on the role of Director of Design in 2015, overseeing the design process for lab projects and day-to-day operations, and directing student research, from undergraduate to PhD. Major projects I directed or collaborated on include:

Data Stethoscope · 2015

This DARPA-sponsored project is a collaboration of artists, designers, and neuroscientists. Data Stethoscope is a desktop application that makes brain data more intimate through sonification. Using fMRI brain scans of individuals 20- to 80-years, this project gives neuroscientists a way to "hear" how connections in the aging brain change over time. The project has broader applications for consumer informatics and data visualization. The visual interface I developed was designed to recede, allowing the sonic interface to drive the user interactions and explorations.

ARTECA · 2016

Launched in 2016, this collaboration with The MIT Press and *Leonardo* journal explored experimental publishing and possible futures for university presses. The platform aim to solve the growing problem of ephemeral data, working archives, and grey literature in the art, science, and technology communities. I led the development of this project, coordinating efforts to teams at The MIT Press (Boston), *Leonardo* (Oakland), and UT Dallas. The project appears in the *The Routledge Handbook of Art, Science & Technology Studies*.

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Curriculum Development in Arts, Sciences, Humanities

CDASH is a resource for faculty interested in art-science-humanities curriculum. It also serves as a data collection point to survey curriculum for innovation and sustainability. I oversaw the development of the platform and crafted the strategy for implementation.

Creative Disturbance · 2014-present

A project in experimental publishing, this international, multilingual podcast platform supports collaboration in the arts, sciences, and technology communities. I oversaw early design research, exploring how podcasts are consumed in order to define user constraints and good practices when producing podcasts. More than 40 channels features 400 podcasts from nearly 300 voices worldwide.

Leonardo eBook Series · 2014, 2015

Oversaw the development of multiple web companions and ebooks published by *Leonardo* and The MIT Press.

USABILITY LAB PROJECTS · UT DALLAS

The ATEC Usability Lab fosters collaborative research with community partners and offers experiential learning to students through sponsored projects. As founding director of the lab, I am also working to integrate use of the lab more richly into the undergraduate and graduate curriculum.

ThoughtNav · 2019

ThoughtNav is an online focus group platform built by Aperio Insights in 2010. The company sponsored an undergraduate research project to conduct *evaluative research* (usability tests) on ThoughtNav; carry out *generative* and *exploratory research* on possible features and functionality; and *synthesize these research insights* into high-fidelity prototypes.

Athenaeum Review · 2018-present

Athenaeum Review publishes essays, reviews, and interviews by leading scholars in the arts and humanities. It is a publication of the School of Arts and Humanities and the Edith O'Donnell Institute of Art History at the University of Texas at Dallas. As Creative Director, I designed multiple issues of the printed journal and oversaw website development. I now review the work of another designer who handles day-to-day design work.

Creative Disturbance · 2013-2020

Creative Disturbance is an international, multilingual network and podcast platform supporting collaboration among the arts, sciences, and new technologies communities. The

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project is an ongoing experiment in publishing, giving art-science professionals another way to represent their work and interests. A successful Kickstarter campaign in 2014 now funds scholarships, allowing students worldwide to produce podcasts. Guests have included philosopher Bernard Stiegler, media artist Michael Naimark, architect Philip Beesley, composer Pauline Oliveros, performance artist Stelarc, computer art pioneer Freider Naker, and Nobel Prize winner Amartya Sen. Selected podcasts are now being permanently archived at The MIT Press.
